- Primary industries are tourism, healthcare, military, and aerospace sciences.
- San Antonio is the 7<sup>th</sup> largest city in the nation with a population of 1,327,407
- The median priced home is \$157, 900, with a required income of \$31,374 to qualify
- Fastest growing occupations: 60.3% growth in medical assistants, 50% growth in network systems and data communication analysts, and 46.2% in database administration
- According to the Texas Workforce Commission Bureau of Labor Statistics 7.3% of individuals were unemployed in 2010, compared to the national average of 9.1%
