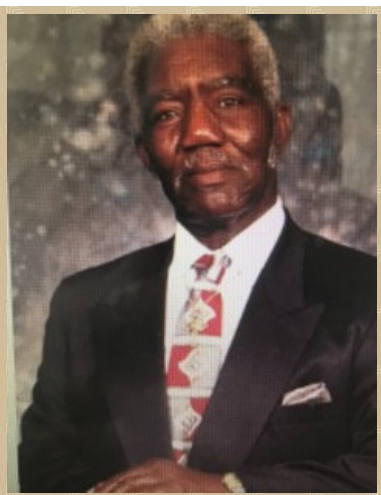


Mr. James Cooper
