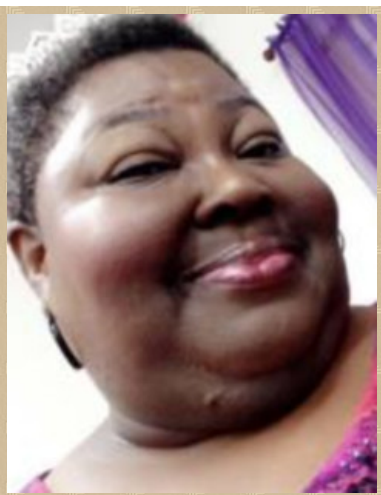


# Ms. Thomas Ann 'Thomasena' Williams
