


Rev. Jesse Roosevelt Timberlake

The Reverend Jesse R. Timberlake 83, of Durham, NC, passed away on February 19, 2019. He served as pastor of Cedar Grove Missionary Baptist Church, Roxboro, NC for 32 years. He retired in 2017.
